PRIOR TO APPOINTMENT

- A valid referral is required well in advance of your appointment either via post, fax, or email.
- To be valid a referral from a GP, Optometrist or specialist must be dated within 12 months. If you are unsure if your referral will be valid, please check with the friendly reception staff
- Please complete all sections of the 'New Patient Form' carefully and email it prior to your appointment.

DAY OF APPOINTMENT

- Please bring your Medicare card, pension card, private health insurance details, DVA card, list of medications, and relevant x-rays and/or scans with you on the day of your appointment.
- Workcover and TAC patients must provide their claim number. Workcover patients must also provide their case manager's name and direct phone number.
- Allow 1.5-2 hours for your appointment in total.
- Extra time may be required if further tests, scans or minor procedures are performed on the day.
- If during the consultation with the doctor you are offered a minor procedure in rooms (such as a cyst removal), you may need to have the eye patched and will not be able to drive home. Public transport, taxi, or someone to drive you home may be required.

APPOINTMENT FEES

Full payment is required on the day of your appointment.

- Longer consultations or complicated cases may incur additional fees at the doctor's discretion.
- There will be extra fees or charges if any further investigations, scans, or procedures are required.
- You may also receive accounts for services associated with your visit such as pharmacy and/or pathology costs.

If you fail to attend your appointment or cancel at late notice, you may need to pre-pay for the next appointment.

PARKING / PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- **PARKING:** There is limited metered parking on Victoria Parade and surrounding streets. Wilson Parking is available for casual rate of approx \$21.00 per hour (90 Victoria Parade via Salvation Lane, P: 1800 727 546, W: www.wilsonparking.com.au/book-a-bay).
- **TRAIN:** You can reach us via Parliament Station, taking the nearest exit to Nicholson Street. For patients coming from the country and need assistance at either Southern Cross or Flinders Street Station, please call Travellers Aid Australia on 1300 700 399.
